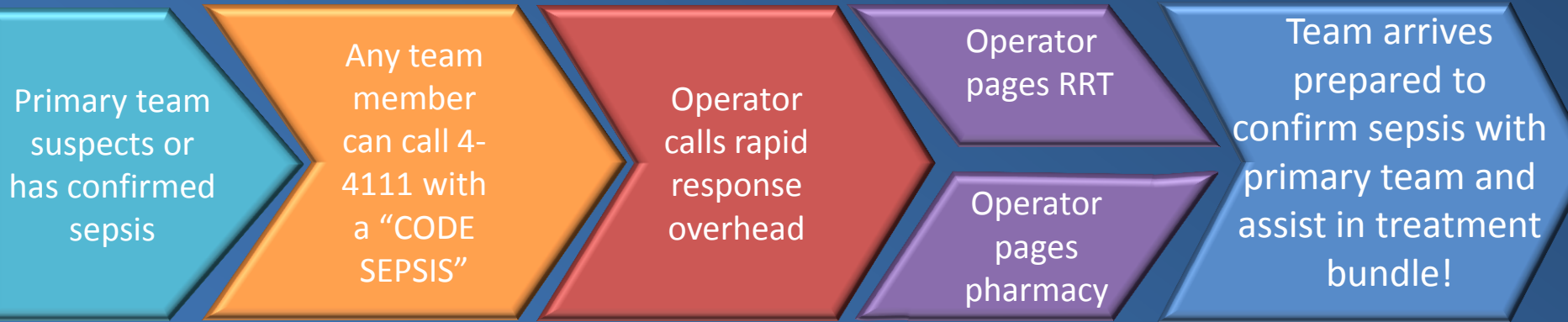


How to Call a Code Sepsis



- Sepsis should be suspected anytime a patient with a known or suspected infection has new or worsening organ dysfunction.
- Clinicians should assess suspected sepsis patients immediately, sepsis can be subtle and patients may deteriorate rapidly.
- Now available for all areas of the Rapid Response Team is a “CODE SEPSIS” process that brings additional hands to the patient and ability for needed labs, IV access, rapid administration of fluids and antibiotics.
- Always use the “Sepsis Bundle” order set for initial treatment of sepsis patients to ensure quick antibiotic availability and appropriate labs, fluid resuscitation choices.
