The University of North Carolina School of Medicine (SOM) seeks an innovative, collaborative leader to serve as the Assistant Dean for Preclinical Curriculum in the Offices of Medical Student Education. This position reports directly to the Associate Dean for Curricular Affairs.

The Assistant Dean for Preclinical Curriculum provides leadership for the preclinical curriculum (Foundation Phase of the Medical Doctorate program). The Assistant Dean will work closely with the Associate Dean for Curricular Affairs, the Assistant Dean for Clinical Curriculum, and the Senior Director for Curricular Affairs to provide a comprehensive, innovative education for medical students in the Foundation Phase with attention to the continued emphasis of the basic sciences in the Application Phase and Individualization Phase. This individual will also work collaboratively with the entire Offices of Medical Student Education at UNC-Chapel Hill and other educational leaders.

The Assistant Dean for Clinical Curriculum will need to dedicate 40% FTE to this position.
